The City of Litchfield is closing out a Public Infrastructure Grant with the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) under the provisions of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The purpose of the meeting is to review program performance and obtain citizen comments regarding program activities and performance under the grant. 1. **Police – Tim Wright** – Discussion regarding the implementation of a substance abuse/mental health program in the City of Litchfield. Presentation by Macoupin County Health Department Director Kent Tarro for the new Safe Passages program
