The City of Litchfield cordially invites the public to attend a Public Information Meeting regarding proposed Park improvements for the Bicentennial Campground Expansion Project. The purpose of the meeting is to seek public input and comments on the proposed preliminary project which includes the addition of 45 parking spots with water and sewer hookups, the addition of a playground area, a shower house, grills, and Martin bird houses. The City is seeking an Open Space Land Acquisition and Development grant which is funded from the Illinois Department of Natural Resources for these improvements. The meeting will be held at the City Hall 120 E. Ryder Street, Litchfield, Illinois 62056 at 6:00 p.m. on August 17, 2023. The project will be presented, and the public may ask questions and provide input and representatives from the City will be available for discussion and to answer questions. Sidewalk Improvement Project

The City of Litchfield will hold a public meeting on Thursday, August 17, 2023 at 6:15 p.m. at City Hall, 120 E. Ryder St., Litchfield, IL 62056 to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed sidewalk improvements project, specifically. The project consists of the construction of new ADA compliant sidewalk (includes new construction and removal and replacement of existing non-compliant sidewalk) to connect Litchfield CUSD #12 to a network of existing and proposed future sidewalk routes. All construction will be ADA compliant and meet all IDOT specifications. The project area is from the intersection of Tyler Ave. and Chestnut St., thence westerly only the south side of Tyler Ave. to State St., thence southerly along the east side of State St. to the Litchfield Community Center (between Jones St. and Fairgrounds Ave.). The city intends to apply for \$250,000 in Safe Routes to School Program – Cycle 2023 funds through the Illinois Department of Transportation.
