Special Meeting Minutes
April 26, 2022

Mayor Steven Dougherty called the Regular Meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present on roll call were Alderpersons Dwayne Gerl, Marilyn Sisson, Dave Hollo, Kassidy Paine, Tim Wright, Woodrow Street and Ray Kellenberger. The Mayor declared that a quorum was present.

New Business:

Alderson Street made a motion, seconded by Alderson Wright to approve a three year mowing and trimming bid for mowing and trimming of various city-owned property and derelict properties around the community. City Administrator Flannery noted that only two bids had been received.

The Mayor directed a roll call vote.

Nay: None.

Motion carried.

Alderson Hollo made a motion, seconded by Alderson Kellenberger to amend the lease, covenants, conditions, and restrictions for the Eagle Ridge Subdivision septic System requirements. It was explained that the Montgomery County Health Department would first issue the permit and then the building and zoning office would follow-up. Building Inspector Gary Baker said that the discharge would be no less than 25 feet from the neighboring property and no less than 50 feet from the lake. An annual inspection would be required, and proof of inspection by a licensed inspector would be required by the City.

The Mayor directed a roll call vote.

Motion carried.


